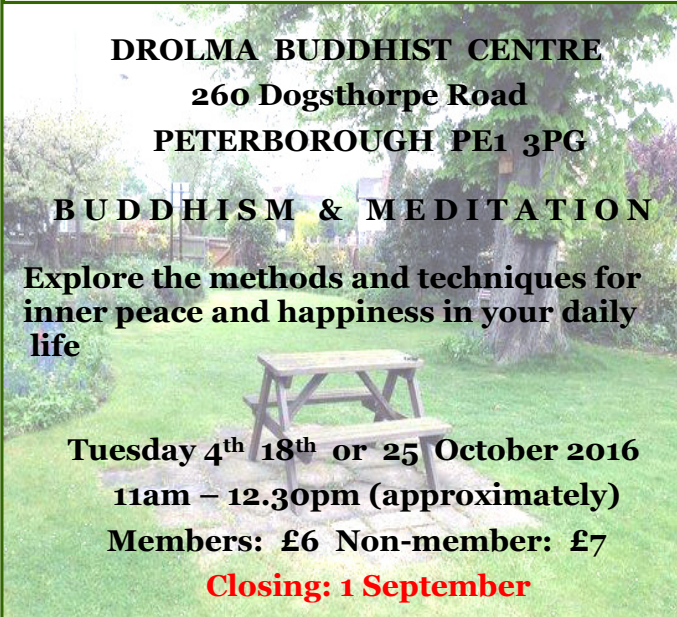

Kasese Uganda – Keeping Girls in School

This project give girls and young women the resources needed to attend school and continue working throughout their menstrual cycles. Menstruation and menstrual practices are clouded by taboos embedded in their religions, culture and history leading to social restrictions for women and adolescent girls.
